Invitation to attend a virtual power plant application workshop on July 21, 2022

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), together with Alberta Environment and Parks (AEP) and the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO), will be holding a virtual power plant application workshop on **Thursday, July 21, 2022, at 1 p.m.** The AUC will begin the workshop by providing information about its regulatory process and application requirements for new power plants, highlight updates and recent changes to its process and identify common application deficiencies that can lead to increased application review times.

Alberta Environment and Parks Approvals will provide an overview of its application process for thermal electric power plant approvals.

The AESO will provide an overview of its interconnection process for new power plants, highlight current work constraints, and identify some common issues that occur in this process.
